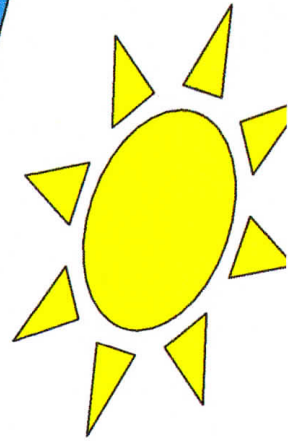

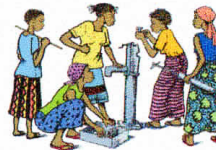

- Have you involved the water/sanitation/health authorities?
- Have you discussed long-term management?
- What are the government policy and the legal frameworks?
- What are the technology choices and maintenance requirements? Consider: technical skills, spare parts and equipment, leadership, financial requirements.
- What has worked/failed in the past?

- Have you involved **women**?
- Who else might be **excluded**?
- Are there different **castes or clans**?
- Are there people with **disabilities or elderly** people with mobility problems?
- Are there people with **HIV/AIDS**?
- Are **children's** needs being met?
- What **livelihood** groups are there and what are their water needs?

- Do committees already exist? Do they work?
- What management structure do people want?
- What training will be needed?

- Have you improved the capacity of: **committees, leaders, community members**?
- What **outside support** is available once you have left?
- Have you involved the government in your handover and exit plans?
